BEACH POLICIES AND RULES

The beach (#1, #2, #3) and the lagoon are for the use and enjoyment of the registered property owners in the Camano Country Club that are current in their annual dues.

Car I.D. tags will be mailed to members by the Office Manager upon receipt of your annual dues. Please display the car I.D. tag on the rear view mirror with the number visible when parking at the beach. If walking please be prepared to give your membership number from your car tag to members of the Beach Committee who may be monitoring the beach areas. If your guests are using the beach areas without you please provide them with your car I.D. tag and membership number. Continuous use of the beach or lagoon area by the same guests is prohibited. You are responsible for your guests.

Dogs must remain on leash at all times and owners are required to clean up after their pets. This will keep our beaches clean for the enjoyment of all who use them.

Children must be kept away from the outflow pipes on beach #1. These pipes carry water to and from the lagoon with the tide changes and produce a fast current at these times. The Beach Corporation will assume **NO** liability if an accident should occur. It is the responsibility of the parents or other persons responsible for the care of the children to be aware of these conditions.

Garbage cans are placed at beach #1 and #2 for the convenience of those members using the beach. Please dispose only of litter that was acquired while using the beach. Sanitary facilities will be installed at these same beaches from Memorial Day to the end of October. Please leave in a clean condition after using.

Gas motors are not to be used on boats in the lagoon. No jumping on the dock that is located directly north of the last house on the east side of the lagoon. This dock is the property of the Beach Corporation and is placed in the lagoon for the enjoyment of our members and their guests. Please do not disturb any of the private docks on the lagoon or trespass on any private property of the homeowners who live in the area of the picnic area and dock.

Any damage or trespassing at beaches #1, #2, #3, or at the Lagoon picnic area will be reported to the Island County Sheriff for investigation.

Boats that are left at beach #1 and #2 must be registered at the Clubhouse with the Office Manager. The owners name must be visible on the boat. Do not block the entry to the beach with your boat. The Beach Corporation will not be responsible for any damage to boats left at the beaches.
